OTHER RESTRICTIONS:

1. NO MORE THEN 500 POUNDS PER VESSEL MAY BE LANDED WITHIN A SINGLE CALENDAR DAY.
 1. FISH MAY NOT BE HELD ACROSS MULTIPLE DAYS. ANY FISH CAUGHT THE FIRST DAY MUST BE LANDED BEFORE PURSUING THE NEXTS DAYS LANDING LIMIT.
 2. ANY PORTION OF LANDED CATCH (UP TO 100 POUNDS) THAT EXCEEDS THE LANDING LIMIT MUST BE DELIVERED TO THE TRIBE FOR CEREMONIAL PURPOSES.
 3. NO MORE THAN 4 FISH PER VESSEL FOR TAKE HOME PURPOSES. CONTACT ENFORCEMENT OFFICER PRIOR TO LANDINGS FOR SAMPLING PURPOSES:

 4. ALL HALIBUT MEASURING LESS THAN 32 INCHES (HEAD AND TAIL ON) MUST BE RETURNED TO WATER UNHARMED.
 5. NO LONGLINE S&C FISHING ALLOWED 14 DAYS PRIOR TO START OF MANAGEMENT PERIOD.
